

## MAY 2025 POLL WORKER TEST

### TRUE/FALSE

1. All copies of the sample ballots from the White Supply Box must be displayed while the polls are open. (p. 13)

  - The voter will not be able to sign the Poll Pad unless a poll worker selects "Ballot/Envelope Remitted" after the voter has remitted their ballot and envelope.
  - The voter should NOT be included on the White Numbered List of Voters under any circumstances
