This is an official notice of the general election to be conducted on Nov. 8 2022 in DELAWARE County. Qualified voters may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at <a href="www.vote.pa.gov">www.vote.pa.gov</a> or <a href="www.vote.pa.gov">www.fvap.gov</a>. Qualified voters may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting an FPCA by fax to (610) 892-0641, or by email to <a href="www.vote.pa.gov">UOCAVA@CO.DELAWARE.PA.US</a>

### Instructions

- FPCA voters may request an absentee ballot at any time prior to a primary or general election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, FPCA voters also may vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB).
- You may use the FWAB to vote for candidates for <u>all</u> federal, state, and local offices, and ballot initiatives.
- To vote, fill out and send in the Voter Information Page (page 2) and Official Backup Ballot (page 3) of the FWAB.
  - o To vote for federal, state, and local offices or for ballot initiatives write the names of candidates or the ballot initiative in the appropriate section of the FWAB.
    - Under the Federal Offices heading, enter the name or party of the federal candidate you choose.
    - Under the Other Offices heading, enter the state or local office, and name or party of the candidate you choose.
    - Under the Ballot Initiative or other items heading, enter the title of the ballot initiative (referendum) you are voting on and write "yes" or "no."
