#### WEEKLY POLICE BLOTTER 02/12/2023 - 02/18/2023

\*The below captions are a summary of significant police responses during the listed week. The blotter does not include all calls for service attended to by the Delaware County Park Police Department.

### • <u>02/12/2023 9:09 PM, (Medical Emergency)</u>

Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division received a call for a medical emergency in Building 8. Officers assisted the Riddle Memorial Hospital (RMH) ambulance paramedics in locating the subject in need of medical care and then assisted in escorting the ambulance back to their ambulance for transport of the patient.

### • <u>02/12/2023 2:02 PM, (Narcotics Possession)</u>

Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex located a pill bottle full of marijuana on an individual screening through the facility security checkpoint. The individual found to be in possession of the marijuana was arrested and criminally charged before being released from police custody on an unsecured bond.

Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division received a call for a medical emergency in Building 8. Officers assisted the Riddle Memorial Hospital (RMH) ambulance paramedics in locating the subject in need of medical care and then assisted in escorting the medical personnel back to their ambulance for transport of the patient.

### • <u>02/14/2023 2:14 PM, (Wanted Person)</u>

Officers assigned to the Chester Division detained and arrested an individual with an active Violation of Probation warrant.

## • <u>02/14/2023 2:40 PM, (Panic/Silent Alarms)</u>

## • 02/14/2023 3:04 PM, (Hazardous Conditions)

While on routine patrol, the day shift Parks Patrol supervisor observed a large set of powerlines down in the roadway on West Rose Tree Road in Upper Providence Township. The Parks Patrol Supervisor advised Park Police dispatch of their findings, and the Pennsylvania State Police was notified as it was in their jurisdiction. The Park Police supervisor remained on the scene until the arrival of PSP.

Officers assisted the Riddle Memorial Hospital (RMH) ambulance paramedics in locating the subject in need of medical care and then assisted in escorting the paramedics back to their ambulance for transport of the patient.

## • <u>02/14/2023 7:05 PM, (Wanted Person)</u>

Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were alerted to a male at the front doors of the complex wishing to turn himself in on an outstanding warrant. Officers confirmed the male in question had an active criminal warrant and arrested him at that time.

## • <u>02/15/2023 2:18 PM, (Disorderly Subject)</u>

Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were called to Hearing Room A-1 for a report of a subject yelling and arguing inside the hearing room. Officers were able to identify and calm the person causing the issue and they were removed from the facility without incident and issued a warning.

## • <u>02/15/2023 10:36 AM, (Panic/Silent Alarms)</u>

Officers assigned to the Chester Division received a report of a panic/silent alarm activation within the Chester Probation Building. Park Police officers as well as officers from the Chester City Police Department responded and found the alarm to be an accidental activation.

## • <u>02/16/2023 12:56 PM, (Harassment)</u>

Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex received a walk-up complaint regarding verbal harassment that occurred outside of one of the facilities' courtrooms between two individuals involved in the same case. The individual accused of verbally harassing the reporting party had already left the facility at the time that the incident was reported to police. A police report was generated.

### • <u>02/16/2023 2:05 PM, (Theft from a Vehicle over \$200)</u>

Officers assigned to Parks Patrol received a report of a theft from a vehicle in Smedley Park. Officers met with the reporting party who believed that their credit and debit cards were taken from their vehicle while it was parked and unattended within the park. A police report was taken on the matter and the Criminal Investigations Division will be investigating the case moving forward.

## • <u>02/16/2023 10:47 PM, (Panic/Silent Alarms)</u>

Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex received a report of a panic/silent alarm activation in one of the public offices within the facility. Officers responded and found the alarm to be an accidental activation.

## • <u>02/17/2023 2:03 PM, (Disorderly Subjects)</u>

Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were called to Hearing Room A-1 for a report of a verbal argument inside of the hearing room. Officers arrived and did not observe an argument but did observe the two parties that were previously arguing. Officers separated and spoke with both parties who agreed to remain peaceful. Delaware County Sheriff's Deputies remained on scene to provide courtroom security.

## • <u>02/18/2023 8:30 AM, (Assist other Agencies)</u>

Officers assigned to Parks Patrol were contacted by Springfield Township Police regarding a search for an individual believed to have been experiencing a medical emergency. Park Police officers recalled seeing an individual fitting the given description exiting the park prior to Springfield Township officers arriving. Working with the information given by our officers, Springfield Township officers were able to locate the individual a short distance from the park and summoned the medical attention the individual needed.
