### WEEKLY POLICE BLOTTER

06/25/2023 – 07/01/2023

\*The below captions are a summary of significant police responses during the listed week. The blotter does not include all calls for service attended to by the Delaware County Park Police Department.

#### **• 06/25/2023 6:30 PM, (Special Detail)**

Delaware County Park Police Officers assisted in traffic control and crowd safety during the Rose Tree Park summer festival concert series.

#### **• 06/26/2023 12:13 PM, (Medical Emergency)**

Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division received a call for a medical emergency in Building 8. Officers assisted the Riddle Memorial Hospital (RMH) ambulance paramedics in locating the subject in need of medical care and then assisted in escorting the paramedics back to their ambulance for transport of the patient.

Officers assigned to Parks Patrol found swimmers in the water at Kent Park during a routine patrol of the park. Officers advised the swimmers to exit the water and informed them that swimming is prohibited there due to the safety issues and no lifeguard being present. The swimmers were issued a warning and released.

• **06/30/2023 2:31 PM, (Panic/Silent Alarms)**

Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex received a report of a panic/silent alarm activation in the Curran Building. Officers responded and found the alarm to be an accidental activation.

• **06/30/2023 7:50 PM, (Alarms/Audible Burglary Alarm)**

Officers assigned to Parks Patrol responded to a report of an audible burglary alarm in one of the buildings within the Don Guanella Property. Arriving officers did not hear an alarm sounding and checked the building in question for anyone who might have possibly entered. No occupants were found at that time and the building was re-secured.

• **07/01/2023 6:47 PM, (Harassment)**

Officers assigned to Parks Patrol received a call for criminal mischief within Upland Park. Arriving officers found there to have been a domestic incident between two parties stemming from a custody exchange. Officers observed damage to the complainant's vehicle consistent with observed injuries to the accused party in the matter. Officers arrested the accused party and transported them to the hospital to be treated before bringing them back to Park Police Headquarters to be housed and processed.
