The “Delco Summer 2021: Summer Camp Solution” program is for Delaware County residents who are unemployed and want to return to work. Caregivers can receive up to \$1,000 in summer camp services from participating Delaware County summer camps (for children under the age of 15) so they are able to look for and return to work.

There is a maximum of \$1,000 per caregiver. This program is funded by Delaware County.

Additional camps are encouraged to apply for the program and will be added to this list upon approval.
