Delaware County Libraries Host Digital Bookmobile National Tour Events *Free event highlights eBooks and audiobooks available from County libraries*

Traveling from coast to coast, the *Digital Bookmobile National Tour* is making stops at the Ridley Township Public Library & Resource Center on Aug. 22 and the Aston Public Library on Aug. 23, both from 10:00a.m. to 4:00p.m. Residents are invited to the interactive exhibit to learn about eBooks and audiobooks available from Delaware County libraries. Both events are free and open to readers of all ages.

Library staff and eReading experts will be available to guide visitors through the easy process of borrowing digital books.

"The Digital Bookmobile is a wonderful event. It will give our community the opportunity to come out and try our eBooks and audiobooks, with plenty of staff on hand to assist them," said Delaware County Libraries Director Catherine Bittle. "This is just one of the many free services that our libraries offer."

Readers of all levels of comfort and familiarity with eBooks are welcome to the Digital Bookmobile events. Staff will facilitate one-on-one tutorials to help visitors borrow and read or listen to eBooks and audiobooks. Equipped with interactive workstations, touchscreen activities, devices to sample titles and more, the Digital Bookmobile has everything a reader needs to get started. Residents can use popular devices, including iPhone, iPad, Android phones and tablets, Chromebook and Kindle to browse content from Delaware County Libraries.

Library cardholders can borrow eBooks and audiobooks free of charge, 24 hours a day, with no late fees on the library's website or by using the Libby app to read or listen instantly from virtually any smartphone, tablet or computer.
