Lost/Stolen License

In the case of a license that is being reported as stolen, lost or misplaced, the system will produce a new license number and will mark the new permit as "NEW".

The original issue and expiration dates remain the same as the original license.

The "Replace Lost/Stolen" process automatically revokes the old permit.*

*If the old permit is eventually found or returned to the Issuing Authority, this can be noted in the LTC system. The old permit should be destroyed.

Duplicate License

In the case of a duplicate license because of a name or address change or a damaged license, etc., The LTC system will generate a permit with the same permit number, issue and expiration dates. The permit will automatically be marked as "Dupl. /Correction".

Since the permit data is maintained and updated in the computerized LTC system automatically, there is no need to send PSP notice that a permit was updated or that a duplicate permit was issued.
