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**\*\*\*BID QUESTIONS, CLARIFICATIONS AND ANSWERS\*\*\***

**Question #1:** Are substitutions allowed? S2, Brivo, Genetec, etc.?

**Answer:** The County will not accept substitutions for this project.

**Question #2:** Can you provide engineer's estimate or budget?

**Answer:** We do not have an engineer's estimate and will not be providing the budget for this project.

**Question #3:** Is Union labor required?

**Answer:** Union labor is not required for this project as it does not exceed the appropriate cost threshold.

**Question #4:** Will a CCure 9000 upgrade to the existing system be accepted as an approved alternate for this opportunity?

**Answer:** There are no approved alternates, so this would not be acceptable.

**Question #5:** When will we have access to the sites?

**Answer:** Each site may have different access needs. For instance, the Briarcliffe Community Center, the times for access and work are much more broad due to how the site is currently being utilized compared to the Government Center. The awarded vendor will coordinate with the Delaware County Park Police to establish an optimal time to access each site, bring the new equipment for that site online while the existing is active and subsequently remove the existing system.
