MONTHLY POLICE BLOTTER

*The below captions are a summary of significant police responses during the listed month. The blotter does not include all calls for service attended to by the Delaware County Park Police Department.

March 2026

- **03/01/2026 1717 Medical Emergency**
Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a medical emergency. Officers promptly responded along with EMS (Emergency Medical Services). Officers stayed on location to assist as needed until EMS transported the patient to the nearest hospital.
- **03/01/2026 1925 Medical Emergency**
Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a medical emergency. Officers promptly responded along with EMS (Emergency Medical Services). Officers stayed on location to assist as needed until EMS transported the patient to the nearest hospital.
- **03/02/2026 1330 Harassment**
Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were dispatched to a report of an individual harassing others in the area. Upon arrival, officers did not witness any harassment and took a report from the complainant and a witness gathering all the information available for further investigation.
- **03/02/2026 1055 Medical Emergency**
Officers assigned to Chester District Court came across an individual complaining of chest pain. Emergency Medical Services (EMS) was called and upon their arrival the Pt. was evaluated and then refused further care. Officers stayed with the individual and assisted as needed prior to clearing the call.

- **03/02/2026 1200 Warrants**
 Officers assigned to Chester District Court were instructed by the on-Duty Judge to take an individual into custody for an outstanding warrant. Officers placed the individual into custody without incident. The subject was later transferred to the Chester City Police Department.
- **03/02/2026 2125 Medical Emergency**
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a medical emergency. Officers promptly responded along with EMS (Emergency Medical Services). Officers stayed on location to assist as needed until EMS transported the patient to the nearest hospital.
- **03/03/2025 1135 Found Drugs/Drug Paraphernalia**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex discovered an individual with a small bag of a green leafy substance believed to be marijuana as well as other drug paraphernalia at a security screening area. The individual admitted the items belonged to them and the officers obtained all information from the individual prior to letting them leave. All confiscated items were submitted as evidence to be destroyed
- **03/04/2026 1020 Harassment**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were dispatched to an allegation of harassment outside one of the courtrooms during court proceedings. All parties' information was gathered, and a brief description of the alleged events was given to the officers. Upon further investigation nothing criminal was found to have occurred and the party making the complaint was informed that other than a report being filed nothing further would happen at this time.
- **03/04/2026 1230 Disturbances**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were dispatched to a report of a disturbance outside one of the courtrooms. Officers arrived at the location and identified the individuals in question who were causing the disturbance and escorted them out of the courthouse for the day.
- **03/04/2026 1630 Accident/Non-Injury**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were dispatched to a report of a pedestrian struck in the parking garage area. Arriving officers discovered the incident to have been two vehicles that hit each other while attempting to exit. Officers verified there were no injuries and took a report prior to allowing the individuals to leave.
- **03/04/2026 2000 Medical Emergency**
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a report of a medical emergency. Officers promptly responded along with EMS (Emergency Medical Services). Officers stayed on location to assist as needed until EMS transported the patient to the nearest hospital.

- **03/05/2026 1020 Disturbances**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were dispatched to reports of a disturbance outside of one of the courtrooms. Upon arrival, officers found 3 parties involved in a verbal dispute. Officers separated all parties and gathered all information prior to allowing all parties to leave the property.
- **03/05/2026 1405 Disorderly Conduct**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were dispatched to reports of a verbal argument outside of one of the courtrooms. Officers arrived and identified an individual still on location, becoming increasingly aggressive towards the others. This subject was placed into custody and escorted to Park Police Headquarters before being released with citations a short time later.
- **03/05/2026 1415 Warrants**
 Officers assigned to the Sharon Hill Probation Office were advised of an individual with an active warrant. Officers took the subject into custody and then later transferred them to a constable unit for transport to Delaware County prison.
- **03/06/2026 1415 Panic Alarm**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were dispatched to a report of a panic alarm inside one of the offices within the complex. Officers arrived to find an individual who was being loud and appeared irate. Officers were able to calm the individual down and determined that the subject's business had already been concluded for the day and then escorted them off property without issue.
- **03/09/2026 1948 Fight-Out**
 Officers assigned to Parks Patrol were dispatched to a report of a large group of juveniles fighting at Upland Park. Upon arrival, officers found no active fighting, but information was gathered on all parties involved before all parties were escorted from the park.
- **03/09/2026 1948 Medical Emergency**
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a report of a medical emergency. Officers promptly responded along with EMS (Emergency Medical Services). Officers stayed on location to assist as needed until EMS transported the patient to the nearest hospital.
- **03/10/2026 1307 Suspicious Package**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were contacted by the Delaware County Sheriff's Office to retrieve a small bag with an unknown substance in it that they had found. Officers met with Sheriff's Deputies and took possession of the item in question. After extensive testing the substance was not found to be a known or common drug and was submitted as evidence to be destroyed.

- **03/10/2026 1552 Medical Emergency**
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a report of a medical emergency. Officers promptly responded along with EMS (Emergency Medical Services). Officers stayed on location to assist as needed until EMS transported the patient to the nearest hospital.
- **03/10/2026 1942 Disorderly Group/Unlawful Assembly**
 Officers assigned to Parks Patrol were dispatched to a report of a large group of juveniles causing a disturbance at Upland Park. Upon arrival, officers made contact with the large group and moved all parties out of the park without further issue.
- **03/10/2026 2225 Fire**
 Officers assigned to Parks Patrol were dispatched to a possible fire/bond fire at Glen Providence parks after hours. All units arrived on location and after some time searching the park nothing was found. All units then cleared.
- **03/11/2026 1905 Disorderly Group/Unlawful Assembly**
 Officers assigned to Parks Patrol were dispatched to reports of a fight involving a large group of juveniles at Upland Park. Officers arrived shortly after Upland PD and found no active fight at this time. Officers removed all juveniles from the park.
- **03/12/2026 0930 Warrants**
 Officers assigned to Chester Probation took an individual into custody after discovering they had an active warrant out of Bucks County. The individual was brought to Park Police Headquarters for processing before being transferred to Delaware county Prison for housing.
- **03/13/2026 0925 Warrants/Probation**
 Officers assigned to Chester Probation took an individual into custody for a Violation of Probation Warrant. While in custody possible stolen property was found. The individual was transported to Delaware county prison and detectives were notified of the possible stolen property to further investigate the matter.
- **03/13/2026 2059 Medical Emergency**
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a report of a medical emergency. Officers promptly responded along with EMS (Emergency Medical Services). Officers stayed on location to assist as needed until EMS transported the patient to the nearest hospital.

- **03/16/2026 1512 Burglary Alarm**
 Officers assigned to Parks Patrol were dispatched to a Burglary Alarm at Upland Park for the Redwood building. Upon arrival the building was found to be secured. Officers conducted a search of the building and the immediate area as a precaution with nothing being found.
- **03/17/2026 0956 Medical Emergency**
 Officers assigned to Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a report of a medical emergency. Officers promptly responded along with EMS (Emergency Medical Services). Officers stayed on location to assist as needed until EMS transported the patient to the nearest hospital.
- **03/17/2026 1137 Medical Emergency**
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a report of a medical emergency. Officers promptly responded along with EMS (Emergency Medical Services). Officers stayed on location to assist as needed until EMS transported the patient to the nearest hospital.
- **03/16/2026 Possession of Weapon**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex discovered a brass knuckles/taser combo while screening an individual at one of security checkpoints. The individual was advised that the item is a prohibited offensive weapon, it was then confiscated and submitted as evidence to be destroyed. Officers obtained the individuals information and released them with a warning shortly thereafter.
- **03/18/2026 Warrants/Probation**
 Officers assigned to the Upper Darby Probation Office were advised of an individual on location that had an active Violation of Probation Warrant. Officers took the subject into custody without incident. The subject was later transferred to Delaware County prison.
- **03/18/2026 1030 Warrants/Probation**
 Officers assigned to the upper Darby Probation Office received a report of an individual with a Violation of Probation Warrant. The subject was taken into custody without incident and then later transferred to Delaware County Prison.
- **03/18/2026 1345 Disorderly Conduct**
 Officers assigned to Chester District Court were advised of an individual causing a disturbance inside of one of the courtrooms. The subject was removed from the courtroom and received a citation for the disorderly conduct.
- **03/19/2026 2008 Suspicious Autos/Person**
 Officers assigned to Parks Patrol discovered an unoccupied vehicle within Smedley Park after hours. The owner was located elsewhere within the park where officers gathered information, advised them of the County Park Ordinance Violation, and released them with a warning.

- **03/20/2026 1041 Drug Possession**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex discovered a small container of marijuana while screening through one of the security checkpoints. The individual possessing the marijuana could not produce a valid medical marijuana card. The marijuana was confiscated and submitted as evidence to be destroyed. Information was obtained on the individual prior to releasing them with a warning.
- **03/23/2026 0912 Medical Emergency**
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a report of a medical emergency. Officers promptly responded along with EMS (Emergency Medical Services). Officers stayed on location to assist as needed until EMS transported the patient to the nearest hospital.
- **03/23/2026 1341 Medical Emergency**
 Officers assigned to Parks Patrol were dispatched along with an ambulance to Rose Tree Park for a report of a medical emergency. Arriving officers found the Patient who was having a medical emergency and stayed on location to assist until Emergency Medical Services arrived to take over.
- **03/25/2026 0956 Disturbances**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were dispatched to a disturbance outside the main entrance. Officers arrived to find multiple parties verbally arguing at this time. Officers de-escalated the situation and separated all parties to gather information. After their initial investigation, officers escorted all parties out of the courthouse through separate exits to prevent any further incidents.
- **03/25/2026 1420 Warrants/Probation**
 Officers assigned to Upper Darby Adult and Juvenile Probation were alerted to an individual who had an active violation of Probation Warrant. Officers took the individual into custody without incident and later transferred them to Delaware County Prison (DCP).
- **03/25/2026 1630 Traffic Citations**
 Officers assigned to Parks Patrol observed a driver using Rose Tree Park as a cut-through to avoid traffic on the main roadway. Upon conducting a traffic stop on the individual it was discovered that the driver had a suspended license. Officers allowed the driver to arrange for a licensed driver to come take possession of the vehicle. The driver was released with citations for the traffic infraction and County Park Ordinance Violation once the licensed driver arrived.

- **03/26/2026 1101 Disorderly Conduct**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were dispatched to a report of a disorderly subject outside of one of the offices within the courthouse. Upon arrival, officers found an individual actively screaming and becoming more aggressive. Officers attempted to De-Escalate and when unsuccessful the subject was taken into custody and later released with a citation for Disorderly Conduct and Harassment.
- **03/27/2026 1748 Building check/open doors or windows**
 Officers assigned to Parks Patrol discovered an open door in one of the buildings within the Delco Woods property. Officers made entry and cleared the building with negative findings. Officers re-secured the door and remained on location conducting a secondary search of the surrounding area before clearing.
- **03/28/2026 1000 Special Detail**
 Officers remained at the Courthouse Complex and surrounding area to provide additional law enforcement presence for a No kings rally that was taking place in Media Borough. The event proceeded with no issues.
- **03/29/2026 1902 Suspicious conditions**
 Officers assigned to Parks Patrol were flagged down by a bystander advising that bones were found in plastic bag inside a tire at the Delco Woods property. Officers initiated an investigation and Park Police Detectives were advised as well. The bones were collected for evidence and after the county medical examiner inspected them it was determined they were not human remains but most likely animal remains. No criminal investigation was carried out at this time with no evidence of foul play being found.
- **03/30/2026 1300 Warrant/probation**
 Officers assigned to the Chester Probation Office were advised of an individual with a Violation of Probation Warrant. Officers took the individual into custody without incident, and the subject was later transferred to DCP.
- **03/31/2026 0938 Panic Alarm/Disorderly subject**
 Officers assigned to the Courthouse Complex were dispatched to an active panic alarm within one of the offices at the complex. Responding officers found an individual in the area that was visibly distraught and becoming loud. Officers were able to de-escalate the situation and calm the subject down. Upon calming down, the individual was allowed to finish conducting their business inside the courthouse before being escorted out.
- **03/31/2026 1348 Medical Emergency**
 Officers assigned to the Fair Acres Division were dispatched to a report of a medical emergency. Officers promptly responded along with EMS (Emergency Medical Services). Officers stayed on location to assist as needed until EMS transported the patient to the nearest hospital.

- **03/31/2026 1930 Disorderly group**

Officers assigned to Parks Patrol discovered a large group of juveniles within Upland Park while checking the park at closing. All individuals were advised that the park was closing and they would have to leave. Officers remained on location following the park closing to ensure it remained empty. Nothing further was reported and all officers cleared.
