We must **RECEIVE** your ballot by 8 pm on Election Day, Nov. 7, 2023

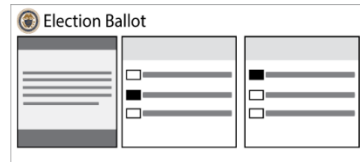

Marking Your Ballot

- Use a blue or black ink pen.
- Fill in the box to the left of each candidate you wish to vote for.
- Do not use the write-in space for a candidate who is already listed for that office.

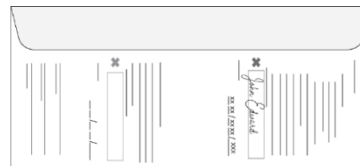
Returning Your Ballot

- Place ballot in the white secrecy envelope labeled “Official Election Ballot.”
- Seal and do not write on or mark the secrecy envelope



3.

- Place the sealed secrecy envelope in your Ballot Return Envelope and seal the Ballot Return Envelope.
- Sign and write today’s date in the Voter’s Declaration section.



We must receive your ballot by 8 pm on Election Day, Nov. 7, 2023.

- By mail – Postage is paid.
- Delaware County Government Center Drop Box – Starting Oct. 9.
- All other Drop Boxes across Delaware County – starting Oct. 23.
Locations and hours listed on reverse side of this sheet.
- Drop boxes close 8 pm Election Day, Nov. 7.

Remember: Whether using a drop box or the US Postal Service, you may deliver only your own Ballot Return Envelope.

Available Services

- Register for the first time or file a name-address-party change now through Oct. 23;
- Vote-by-Mail applications (both Mail-in and Absentee) now through Oct. 31;
- Replacement ballots for voters who did not receive the ballot, or who damaged, mismarked or lost the mail-in ballot - through Nov. 7;
- Emergency Absentee processing Nov. 1-7; and,
- Answers to other questions.

ELECTION HOTLINE

Delaware County Elections maintains an Election Hotline at (610) 891-VOTE [610-891-8683]. The hotline is staffed Monday through Friday, from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm., and on Election Day, Tues., Nov. 7, from 5:30 am to 12 midnight.

WARNING: If you return a Mail/Absentee ballot by the deadline, you may not vote at your Election Day polling place, except:

(1) If have not properly submitted the Mail/Absentee ballot by Election Day, you may vote a provisional ballot at your polling place.

(2) If you remit (surrender) your Mail/Absentee ballot **and** your Ballot Return Envelope, the Judge of Election at your polling place should void that ballot and envelope, and then let you vote a standard Election Day ballot.
