INSTRUCTIONS

- Petition must be signed by ten (10) registered voters of the same Precinct/Ward of the office. The Circulator of the Petition must reside and be a registered voter in the corresponding district/ward and precinct. The Circulator of the Petition signs the Petition where indicated in the presence of a Notary Public who must complete the Notary statement.
- The Judge of Elections appointed to fill the vacancy **must be of the political party having the majority of votes** in said district at the last preceding November election. To determine the majority party, review the Official Precinct results for the immediate prior November election and find the candidate in the precinct/ward who has the highest vote. The identified party of the candidate with the highest vote in that precinct determines the party that may fill the vacant Judge of Election office.
- Five (5) of the Notice cards must be POSTED (on poles, buildings, etc.) in the Precinct/Ward and one (1) Notice card must be posted at the polling place. The Seventh Notice Card is to be returned to the Bureau of Elections with the Petition.

The six (6) notice cards must be posted at least five (5) days before the Court date. Refer to the attached listing of Court dates.

- The person who hangs the posting must sign the Affidavit of Posting in the presence of a Notary Public who must complete the Notary statement.
- One (1) week before the Court Date, the following must be completed and returned to the Bureau of Elections:
 - 1. The notarized affidavit of posting indicating that the notices were posted
 - 2. One (1) of the Notice Cards that has been posted within your Precinct/Ward and at the Polling Place
 - 3. Completed Candidate's Affidavit
 - 4. Completed Petition
 - 5. If there was a resignation it must also be returned
